### Several Brookhaven based businesses received New York State awards under Governor Cuomo's Statewide Competition

#### Anneal Pharmaceuticals

Awarded \$3,000,000 as part of a \$65 million expansion that will add 300,000 square feet and create an additional 400 jobs.

#### Blue Green Farms

Awarded \$517,293 toward a project which will produce hydroponic vegetables and an aquaculture system to raise edible fish.

#### Brookhaven Science Associates

Awarded \$5 million to develop a smarter grid research innovation as a joint venture between Brookhaven National Laboratory and Stony Brook University.

#### G4 Synergetics

Awarded \$1.5 million towards the acquisition of a building to manufacture high technology products for transportation, utilities and military.

#### United Baking – Uncle Wally's

Awarded \$1,469,419 toward the acquisition of a new building and equipment with a workforce expansion of 30-40 positions.
